Greek shipping has indelibly marked every important period of Greece's past and present. It is therefore a commonly held belief and desire, among both the young and elder members of the shipping community, to continue to positively contribute towards our country and its history.

In recent years the shipping community, through the Union of Greek Shipowners (UGS), has implemented various initiatives to support a large number of vulnerable social groups that have been deeply affected by the adverse economic conditions in our country. These initiatives have focused on the provision of food and medical care, supporting organizations and social welfare institutions, and strengthening maritime education, thereby placing the shipping community in solidarity with fellow citizens who struggle for a decent living.

The culmination of this collective action was the decision to establish a separate legal non-profit entity, SYN-ENOSIS, the Greek Shipowners' Social Welfare Company. The objective of this social welfare entity is to undertake systematic and organized initiatives nationwide that give prominence to the significant social impact of the shipping community in Greece.

The social welfare programme "WE CONTINUE – WE SUPPORT" forms the inaugural activities of the new entity SYN-ENOSIS for the three year period 2016 – 2018. We wholeheartedly urge you to respond positively to this new social responsibility initiative of the Greek shipping community and associated efforts to support our country.

The shipping community's members, through their social initiatives, responsibly and consistently support our country at all times.

Continuing a multi-year history of social support, and amid the economic crisis in recent years, the Union of Greek Shipowners established the Solidarity Fund in aid of vulnerable social groups to which 148 members of the shipping community have contributed. With their assistance, various actions were implemented in support of citizens affected by the adverse conditions. It is noteworthy that these efforts resulted in the following:

- 240,000 monthly support packages containing food and personal hygiene items for 11,000 families in need with underage children, in 119 regions throughout Greece
- Free medical care and checkups for 18,000 adults and children, in cooperation with the organization DOCTORS OF THE WORLD - GREEK DELEGATION
- Basic supplies for 60 social welfare organizations, situated in 20 cities throughout Greece
- Renovation works and infrastructure upgrading at 4 Merchant Marine Academies
- The provision of equipment and supplies to the Greek Armed Forces, Public Hospitals and Public Organizations, as well as the completion of public interest social projects

The Greek shipping community consistently aspires to responsibly lead and improve the Greece of tomorrow with its ongoing support.



“WE CONTINUE-WE SUPPORT” SOCIAL WELFARE PROGRAMME 2016–2018

The Greek Shipowners' Social Welfare Company SYN-ENOSIS continues the Greek shipping community's social work, aiming to actively support vulnerable groups. Specifically, for the three year period 2016–2018, the social contribution activities will focus on the following areas:

- Food aid
- Health
- Social care
- Maritime education
- Social projects of public interest

FOOD AID

SYN-ENOSIS, in cooperation with social care organizations, will secure the provision of food and personal hygiene supplies for families with underage children living in conditions of deep poverty.

HEALTH

SYN-ENOSIS, in cooperation with medical organizations, will secure the provision of free medical care and checkups for social groups that for economic or social reasons do not have access to healthcare services.

SOCIAL CARE

SYN-ENOSIS will support organizations, institutions and social welfare units protecting vulnerable social groups through the provision of basic food supplies, heating oil, repair works and/or equipment.

MARITIME EDUCATION

SYN-ENOSIS will undertake repair and restoration works, as well as the upgrading of physical infrastructure of the Merchant Marine Academies, to support maritime education.

SOCIAL PROJECTS OF PUBLIC INTEREST

SYN-ENOSIS will undertake projects of the greater public interest and projects which aim to alleviate the negative impact of emergency conditions.

DONATION OPTIONS

The annual donation may be directed to different support areas during the three year period, according to the will of the contributor.

C. Fund – adopt a social project:

Donation for the exclusive funding and implementation of a social project chosen by the contributor.

DONATION CATEGORIES

Fund the social welfare programme of the shipping community by choosing one of the following categories:

- € 300,000 and above..... Grand Benefactor
- € 200,000 to € 299,999 Benefactor
- € 100,000 to € 199,999 Grand Grantor
- € 50,000 to € 99,999 Grantor
- € 30,000 to € 49,999 Grand Supporter
- € 10,000 to € 29,999 Supporter

The above sums concern donations for the funding of social support activities for one year and are expected to be deposited annually during the three year period.

Indicatively, a donation of € 10,000 secures one of the following for one year:

- Food aid for **15** families in need with underage children
- Free medical care and checkups for **220** inhabitants of distant regions
- Basic supplies or heating oil for **3** organizations that protect vulnerable social groups
- Provision of technological equipment for **4** public educational units
